Some relevant information about our group: All chapters of KAMO can be considered as 501(c)(3) charitable organizations with our Employer Identification Number (EIN) of 30-0437586. All contributions to state KAMO or KAMO chapters must be used for KAMO purposes. Income and expenditures must be filed with our state treasurer soon after the end of each half year. Individual members of KAMO must pay for and pass a background check and pay annual dues of \$15. Continuing members must pass a background check every 5 years thereafter, usually paid for by the chapter. Each chapter contributes to state expenses such as liability insurance and web site management once per year as KAMO state dues (\$600 in 2016). New chapters have reduced dues responsibility during their first years. As a prerequisite for chapter acceptance, we require at least 3 of the following 4 officer positions to be filled before filing this application.
